

HS MINISTRY SUMMER CAMP FAQ's

REGISTRATION

Q: When will be the last day to register?

A. June 9, 2024.

Q: What are the registration prices?

A. \$424/student for early registration (until May 12th); \$474/student standard.

Q: What is included in the registration?

A. Lodging, meals (breakfast, lunch, dinner, snacks), transport to/from camp, access to facilities (skeet shooting, lake day, etc.), and camp kit (T-shirt, notebook, team shirt).

TRANSPORTATION

Q: Will transportation be provided?

A. Yes, students will be transported by bus.

Q: Where and when should we drop off and pick up our student(s)?

A. Departure from Faith Bible Church Property is on June 12th at 5:00 am, and return is on June 16th at 1:00 pm.

AT THE CAMP

Q: Will any youth leaders that aren't from FBC be in charge of overseeing our kids during the retreat?

A. Faith Bible leadership will be responsible for overseeing the students.

Q: What is the youth to adult ratio at the retreat?

A. The ratio is 1 adult per 4 students, subject to final registration numbers.

Q: What are the sleeping arrangements and how many adults to kids in the rooms?

A. Tents are gender-separated. Each room will have 1-2 leaders, based on room sizes.

Q: What measures will be taken to ensure the safety of our children (i.e. not being left alone, bathroom procedures, etc.)?

A. An adult will always accompany students away from the group (e.g., bathroom). The group will mostly move together, ensuring multiple leaders are present.

Q: How many teaching sessions will there be?

A. There will be 7 sessions, each including a game, praise, a message, and discussion groups.

Q: What types of activities will be available?

A. Activities include Modern Warfare themed competition, skeet shooting, lake day, archery, basketball, volleyball, pond games, spikeball, coffee cart, craft table and more.

Q: Should my student bring money?

A. Students are encouraged to bring money for the coffee cart, snack shack and any 70aks camp merch they would like to purchase.

COMMUNICATION & TECHNOLOGY

Q: How can students be contacted while they are there or when they arrive?

Q: What is the electronics policy while they are at the retreat? Are students allowed to bring phones, tablets, etc.?

A. No, per Camp 70aks rules, students are not allowed to bring phones, tablets, laptops, etc.
